Principal Searches Underway at Wakanda & Downsville Elementary Schools

Due to the retirement of two long-time principals, the School District of the Menomonie Area has two elementary principal vacancies for the 2023-2024 school year. After some internal movement with administrative staffing, the vacant principal positions for next year are available at Wakanda and Downsville Elementary Schools.

Plans for a comprehensive search for the next principals at Wakanda and Downsville Elementary Schools have been developed, and in an effort to find terrific candidates that will be a great fit for both the school district and the community, it is anticipated that this search will be conducted under the following format:

<u>Tentative Hiring Timeline</u>

February 9:	The vacancies will be posted locally and on statewide networks
Feb. 9-14:	Staff at Wakanda & Downsville will help develop candidate profiles
Feb. 17-Feb. 23:	Student/parent/community input provided through digital surveys
Feb. 24:	Candidates selected and notified of the interview schedule
March 2-3:	First round of interviews with staff/admin hiring committee
March 7-8:	Reference checking and final interviews with admin team (if needed)
March 8-10:	Negotiate contracts with preferred candidates
March 20:	Contracts for preferred candidates recommended to the Board
TBD:	Community/staff "Meet & Greets" will be scheduled at each building
